#### The Law and Your Business

The Law and Your Business – Plumbing Subcontractor is Awarded Prevailing Party Attorney's Fees against General Contractor per Fla. Stat. § 57.105(7).

In *Progressive Plumbing, Inc. v. Kast Constr, II, LLC* there was a contract dispute between a plumbing subcontractor and a general contractor regarding two construction projects located in St. Petersburg, FL (STP) and North Palm Beach, FL (NPB). The plumbing subcontractor claimed that it was owed for work completed on the projects and that the general contractor had refused to return a booster pump used to maintain water pressure on the NPB project. Both subcontracts for the NBP and the STP projects contained a prevailing party attorney's fees clause <u>for the Contractor</u> in the event that the subcontractor delays or otherwise defaults under the subcontract. Florida law, however, equalizes the recovery of attorney's fees by providing that, if a contract awards one party reasonable attorney's fees, then the other party may have such recovery if it is the prevailing party.


Here, the plumbing subcontractor was deemed the prevailing party on both contracts, therefore, it was entitled to reasonable attorney's fees for both contracts per the statute. Further, the court explained that the plumbing subcontractor's claims for breach of contract and fraud/conversion against the general contractor sought the same remedy - to recover under the contracts. And the subcontractor's contract and fraud/conversion claims arose from the same core facts. As a result, there was no need for the subcontractor to separate its legal fees between those incurred in litigating the contract claims versus those incurred in litigating the related legal claims for fraud/conversion. Thus, in addition to its damages, the subcontractor was awarded all of its costs and attorney's fees incurred in pursuing the claims subject to minor adjustments for reasonableness.

### SAFETY NEWS

#### SUMMER IN FLORIDA

Summer comes every year and we have to prepare for the onslaught of hot humid Florida days that seem to last forever. Along with those hot humid days is our exposure to the conditions that complicate our work because it becomes a determining factor in productivity and performance. OSHA has information on working in high heat conditions on their website. NUCA has toolbox talks that focus on heat awareness, and there are products like Gatorade and Sqwincher that provide electrolyte supplements. There is a lot of information out there that contain a heat index charts and other suggestions that can serve as a guide for taking the necessary steps to protect our employees from the harmful effects of working in hot humid conditions.

Some basic suggestions are to use sunscreen, wear clothing that shields your skin from the sun, drink plenty of fluids and be sure to replenish electrolytes lost through perspiration. Ultra violet rays from the sun will damage your eyes. Look for safety glasses that have a rating of 99%-100% ultra violet protection. Be aware of the stages of heat effects on the body. Heat cramps, heat exhaustion and heat stroke are the three stages of heat illness indications. Heat cramps are muscle spasms in the arms, legs or abdomen. Heat exhaustion indicators are low blood pressure, rapid pulse and even fainting. The most serious is heat stroke that can lead to unconsciousness and even death. People suffering heat stroke have to be hospitalized. Taking breaks, finding shade, planning our days to get the heaviest work done during the early morning hours or even considering night work are all things that could be implemented.

Our summers are brutal but if we take steps to mitigate the risk of working in summer heat, we can complete our heat season safely.
