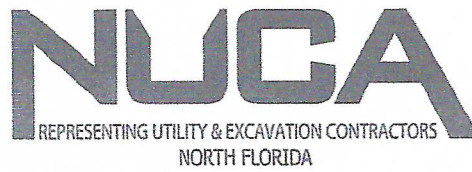

As of right now we are experiencing an economic contraction that is unparalleled throughout the entire history of the United States. This is a result of a pandemic that has ripped through the entire world because the Chinese Communist Party was intellectually dishonest to the world. If I were running for president my platform would consist of a three pronged plan to ensure the safety of the American Citizen, save and rejuvenate the strongest economy in the world, and punish the Chinese Communist Party for the destruction that their deception brought upon the world.
